Please provide the following documents and information:

I. <u>Organizational Documents</u>

- A. Complete corporate organizational charts for the Business.
- B. Certificate of incorporation and bylaws (or similar organizational documents) and all amendments thereto for the Company.
- C. All other documents with respect to any partnership, limited liability company or joint venture arrangements of the Company, including partnership, shareholder, limited liability company or joint venture agreements and all other documents necessary or appropriate under applicable state law to determine the due organization, qualification or good standing of each such partnership, limited liability company or joint venture.
